



<p><b>Survey results</b> Our recent survey of childrens feelings towards a range of school life issues, highlighted some unhappiness about the equality of 'treats' between children with lots of good to be green stickers and those struggling to gain the stickers. After class consultations, staff have amended the behaviour rewards policy to include a weekly VIP lunch in the Learning Mentor Lounge for children chosen from the good to be green list from the various classes; a draw from the same list enabling children to chose time on the Wii or taking part in an activity in the Learning Mentor Lounge with Miss Adams, as well as the usual end of term treat for those who do well.
